The Committee on Natural Resources has scheduled a markup beginning on **Tuesday July 25, 2017, at 4:00 p.m.** The Committee will consider the following bills:

- H.R. 825 (Rep. Paul Gosar), To promote the development of renewable energy on public land, and for other purposes. "Public Lands Renewable Energy Development Act";
- H.R. 873 (Rep. Mike Gallagher), To authorize the Global War on Terror Memorial Foundation to establish the National Global War on Terrorism Memorial as a commemorative work in the District of Columbia, and for other purposes. "Global War on Terrorism War Memorial Act";
- H.R. 965 (Rep. Ann Kuster), To redesignate the Saint-Gaudens National Historic Site as the "Saint-Gaudens National Historical Park", and for other purposes. "Saint-Gaudens National Historical Park Redesignation Act";

Greg Walden**), To adjust the eastern boundary of the Deschutes Canyon-Steelhead Falls Wilderness Study Area in the State of Oregon to facilitate fire prevention and response activities in order to protect adjacent private property, and for other purposes. "Crooked River Ranch Fire Protection Act";
- H.R. 2083 (Rep. Jamie Herrera Beutler), To amend the Marine Mammal Protection Act of 1972 to reduce predation on endangered Columbia River salmon and other nonlisted species, and for other purposes. "Endangered Salmon and Fisheries Predation Prevention Act";
- H.R. 2199 (Rep. Kevin Cramer), To improve Federal land management, resource conservation, environmental protection, and use of Federal real property, by requiring the Secretary of the Interior to develop a multipurpose cadastre of Federal real property and identifying inaccurate, duplicate, and out-of-date Federal land inventories, and for other purposes. - H.R. 3279 (Rep. Paul Cook), To amend the Mineral Leasing Act to provide that extraction of helium from gas produced under a Federal mineral lease shall maintain the lease as if the helium were oil and gas. "Helium Extraction Act of 2017"; and
- H.R. 3281 (Rep. Doug Lamborn), To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to facilitate the transfer to non-Federal ownership of appropriate reclamation projects or facilities, and for other purposes. "Reclamation Title Transfer and Non-Federal Infrastructure Incentivization Act."
