## A BILL

To adjust the eastern boundary of the Whychus-Deschutes Wilderness Study Area in the State of Oregon to facilitate fire prevention and response activities to protect adjacent private property, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Crooked River Ranch
- 5 Fire Protection Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. FINDINGS.
- 7 Congress finds the following:

1	(1) The Crooked River Ranch is an unincor-
2	porated community with a population of 5,000 resi-
3	dents.
4	(2) The current lands located adjacent to
5	Crooked River Ranch are managed by the Bureau of
6	Land Management and are classified as a Wilder-
7	ness Study Area.
8	(3) There is currently only one entrance/exit to
9	the Crooked River Ranch.
10	(4) Jefferson County and Crooked River Ranch
11	have determined that the Wilderness Study Area
12	lands are in the highest risk category for exposure
13	to devastating wildfire due to overstocked juniper
14	stands under the federally mandated and locally pro-
15	mulgated Jefferson County Community Wildfire
16	Protection Plan (CWPP).
17	(5) The current Wilderness Study Area classi-
18	fication prevents mechanical fire prevention activities
19	within the overstocked juniper stands.
20	(6) Advancing this proposed legislation will
21	greatly enhance the life and safety of people and
22	property by reducing the extreme fire threat to these
23	lands.

## SEC. 3. BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENT, WHYCHUS-DESCHUTES 2 WILDERNESS STUDY AREA, OREGON. 3 (a) Boundary Adjustment Required.—The Secretary of the Interior shall adjust the eastern boundary 4 5 of the Whychus-Deschutes Wilderness Study Area in the State of Oregon to exclude approximately 832 acres, as 6 depicted on the map entitled "Wyhchus - Deschutes Wil-7 8 derness Study Area" and dated December, 2015, in order to facilitate fire prevention and response activities on the 9 10 excluded public lands and adjacent private property. 11 (b) EFFECT OF EXCLUSION.—Effective on the date of the enactment of this Act, the public lands to be ex-12 cluded from the Whychus-Deschutes Wilderness Study 13 Area pursuant to subsection (a) are no longer subject to

section 603(c) of the Federal Land Policy and Manage-

16 ment Act of 1976 (43 U.S.C. 1782(c)).
